

CRANE TRUCK CAPABILITIES

In most delivery situations the following is possible to determine positioning of a toilet on site.

The crane is able to lift over a standard size 6' fence as long as there is ample clearance above IE 2.5m clearance from power lines, no low hanging tree branches or any house eaves that may obstruct the operation of the crane.

The crane has the capability to lower a toilet down to a point of 2 meters below the truck. IE down a hole as long as the truck can get to a point no further away than 500mm from the drop zone. The crane can also lift a toilet up to a point 3.5 meters above the level of the truck but as long as it is no further away than 500mm.

Wherever possible all customers who require a toilet delivery should try and have a level 1200mm x 1200mm pad or cleared space for the toilet to be placed.

Please be aware that toilets cannot be tilted more than a 35° angle as there is a major hazard of spillage occurring, so this means that toilets cannot be delivered under carports or garages or anything lower than 2200mm.

Toilets are often collected with waste still in them (**especially weekend hire toilets**) so it is advised that if a toilet has to be delivered to the back yard or has to manoeuvred into and out of place by hand that it will incur a additional **servicing charge** as the toilet will need to be pumped out before collection.
